- Unsafe work practices and procedures,
- Systems of work that do not meet legislated standards.

The hazards addressed during a legislative compliance audit are determined by the workplace environment.

2. Hazard Specific Audits

It will address use of hazardous substances, and involve the inspection and testing of current workplace control methods.

Seven elements relating to workplace will be addressed in this audit. They include:

- Hazard identification, risk assessment and control
- Work environment
- Noise
- Electricals
- Hazardous substances
- Manual tasks
- Information, instruction and training

3. Management System Audits

The audit will look into;

- Workplace structures, planning activities, responsibilities, implemented procedures, review cycles and measurement and evaluation issues.
- The existence of a safety and health policy that is communicated to staff,
- management commitment,
- Allocation of responsibilities
- Accountability for health and safety matters; consultation, hazard identification, evaluation and control, provision of information and training of staff, incident recording, investigation, analysis and review, measuring and evaluating work safety and health performance.
